English Language Arts:

CKLA Unit 5: Geology

This week we will begin our next unit, which focuses on geology. In this unit, students will learn about the earth, its geological features, the rock cycle, weathering, erosion, and how these geological processes affect earth's landscapes and environment through information text reading and skill practice. Our first few lessons focus on reviewing prior knowledge, reading about geological processes, answering comprehension questions using text evidence, commas, suffixes, and similes.

This week we will also take our ELA district interim assessment. This assessment assesses students on ELA standards that were taught, but it does not affect their grade. I will use the data to determine what skills need to be retaught/revisited.
