

Estrella Material Distribution August 13th & 14th

Dear Estrella Families,

The start of the 20-21 school year is upon us. This is not the school year that we wanted but I know the Estrella community will make the best of this challenging situation. I am excited to face it all with you. Below you will learn about how we plan to distribute instructional materials including technology on August 13th and 14th. All families will need to collect materials from the school so please make arrangements to come to Estrella during one of the pick up windows below.

Before I get into the details I want to share that we have had many families contact us this week asking if we were going to distribute laptops. The answer is, "Yes". If you NEED a device for your child to access the digital learning environment, we can provide one. Please know that the computers we are providing do not have any special features, so any computer or similar web connecting device will work. We want to ensure that we have enough computers for our students that need them, so if you already have something that will work, please decline the offer.

The distribution schedule is based on grade levels to avoid overloading the process and allow you to see familiar faces at that grade. In the event that you have multiple students you may pick up all the items at one of your assigned times so you do not have to make multiple trips. If you cannot make any of the assigned times we have offered "open" pick-up times where any family can come and collect their items.

Schedule for pick up:

August 13th

- · Kindergarten 9:00 AM
- · First Grade 10:00 AM
- · Second Grade 11:00 AM
- Open pick up time 3:00 PM 4:00 PM

August 14th

- Open pick up time 7:00 AM 9:00 AM
- · Third Grade 9:00 AM
- · Fourth Grade 10:00 AM
- · Fifth Grade 11:00 AM

Process for pick up:

Parents will pull up to Estrella from the west (coming from 24th street) and after picking up their materials they will turn right out of the Estrella parking lot and head back to 24th street. We anticipate that there will be a lot of traffic between Akimel and Estrella and following this traffic flow process will reduce congestion. Parents will turn into the parking lot between Akimel and Estrella and follow the bus lane up to the drive through gate near Estrella. Staff will then check in with the driver and find out the following information:

Who is your student(s)?

What is your child's ID number?

Will your child need a computer?

This information will be collected on a sheet of paper and attached to your vehicle.

You will be directed to proceed on the fire lane behind the school to collect your items. When your arrive at the Ramada staff will bring out the items you requested and place them in your vehicle. At no time will you need to get out of your car. Once you have your items you will be directed to proceed around the west side of Estrella where you will re-enter the parking lot and exit to the right toward 24th street.
